How to write the admission essay?

Useful tips.

1. The essay should be written in academic style of writing.

Use standard, correct English, write clearly and objectively, use the technical vocabulary.

2. Use this recommended essay structure.

Essay title and the name of the author

Introduction :

- a. Brief background and/or current situation, including differing opinions on the topic*
- b. Definition of a key term (if necessary)*
- c. Outline/main aim of the essay*

Main body consisting of a number of paragraphs each of which may include:

- d. A topic sentence stating the main argument/point of that paragraph*
- e. Development of the key arguments or points, showing different viewpoints*
- f. Reference to sources, statistics and data to support writer's view*
- g. A concluding sentence (not always necessary)*

Conclusion:

- h. Summary of the essay's key points*
- i. Statement clarifying the author's general conclusion and why it is significant, referring back to the essay question*
- j. Wider implications and future action*

List of references and other sources

3. Submit us your own work.

Please bear in mind that the essay is expected to be your own work that should show your ability to use your knowledge, experience and the information available from the sources you decide to refer to, to form your own opinions and to present them in a well-structured way.

4. Do references.

Whenever you refer to outside sources of information, you must cite the sources from which you drew information according to one of the common reference systems (Oxford, Harvard,...).

All essays will be checked for plagiarism (including translations).

5. Topics?

Topics are related to the EDA study requirements.

In the past years, there were for example following topics for the admission exam:

- **IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON SOCIO-ECONOMIC INDICATORS IN A SELECTED COUNTRY**
- **UNEMPLOYMENT RATE BY GENDER**

The recommended length of the essay is 2.000 words.
