


Proof of English proficiency

Admission procedure to Information Systems Management
and Economic Data Analysis Master's degree programs

Applicants are asked to submit a proof of English proficiency at level B2 or higher according to CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages), accepted are these language certificates (certificates have to be valid):

- IELTS at level 6 or higher,
- TOEFL iBT 78 or higher,
- Duolingo 110 or higher,
- Cambridge B2 First (FCE), C1 Advanced (CAE), C2 Proficiency (CPE)
- or a proof confirming completion of study of at least a bachelor's study program taught in English.

The proof of English proficiency is not required from native speakers of English.
